- Gold Standard: Beers that score 120+ points out of 150 are rated as Gold Standard (Excellent to Oustanding for the style).
- Silver Standard: applies to beers that score between 105 and less than 120 points (Very good to excellent for the style)
- Bronze Standard: applies to beers that score between 90 and less than 105 points (Very good for the style)
